Her Joy: To know that God cared, that he saw her suffering and heard her cry, and that he helped her when she needed him most.

At the Chrism Mass, the Holy Chrism is consecrated and the oil of catechumens and oil of the sick are blessed. This beautiful Mass manifests the communion of the priests with their bishop in the same priesthood and ministry of Christ.
