

IMPORTANCE OF REGISTERING AS A MEMBER OF SAINT DOMINIC PARISH

You can be registered in the following ways:

- ◆ Calling the office during business hours
 - (Service in Spanish on Wednesdays from 4 to 7 p.m.)
- ◆ Completing and printing the form and sending it to the office.
 - Registration forms can be found on our website.
- ◆ Visit us in the office during business hours.
- ◆ Make use of the envelopes that you will receive in the mail each month.

Benefits of being a registered member:

- ◆ You and your family can receive the sacraments of initiation: Baptism, First Communion, and Confirmation.
- ◆ You can receive benefits in the special contribution for active parishioners at your wedding ceremony, Quinceañeras or funerals.
- ◆ You can request letters of reference for various personal and or legal reasons (for example: letters for immigration matters).
- ◆ You can use the envelopes as proof of address.
- ◆ Letters of authorization or permission to be godparents and/or to receive sacraments in other parishes.
- ◆ Scholarships for your children to attend Catholic schools.
- ◆ Receive your annual contribution report for use as a tax reduction.
- ◆ Community service hours may be served at St. Dominic Parish.

Use of envelopes:

- ◆ Use the envelopes to make your regular donation when attending Mass.
 - In case you forget your envelopes when attending Mass, you can send them directly to the parish office.
- ◆ Notify the secretary when change of address and/or telephone number.
- ◆ When you stop using the envelopes for 3 months in a row, the envelopes will be canceled, and you will be considered to be an inactive member of St. Dominic Parish.

Note: The amount you can donate is **NOT** the most important thing, using the envelopes is. Using the envelopes can help us determine whether you are an active or inactive member.
